Lecture Phase Format

Is your lecture phase delivered using the standard 12 weeks / 50 hour week full time format or is there a different structure that you are using? How does your format suit the needs of the learners coming to do your course? For example: The lecture phase is spread over two years with total learning time of 700 hours overall. It is also fully integrated with the field assignment. Each week includes both "lecture phase" learning and "field assignment" ministry application. We do this because we are training people who are also staffing YWAM ministries and are receiving training while continuing to work with that ministry on our base.

This will be a six week Seminar of acting. During these six weeks the students will be introduced to many different methods of acting such as Stanislavsky method, Suzuki method and Meinsner and many others. They will be given the opportunity to apply these methods while acting in various short films, scene studies and monologues.

Outreach Format

Please describe your training approach for this outreach and why you do it that way. For example: The outreach is conducted over 12 weeks including a one week final debrief. Most days will start with a an intercession or worship time focused on the people we are ministering to. The students are involved in contributing to planning the ministry activities and each take turns in various roles during those activities. This ensures that all of the students gain practice and confidence in each of the aspects of ministry. We include group debrief times as well as on-on-ones to process what has been learned during the ministry and identify areas where more development is needed in each student.

This will be a six week Seminar Practicum of acting. During this 6 week practicum the students will be introduced and get practice many different methods of acting such as Stanislavsky method, Suzuki method and Meinsner and many others. They will be given the opportunity to apply these methods while acting in various short films, scene studies and monologues.

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
